

MEDICAL EMERGENCY

All Personnel

- Call Security at (805) 730-4200 and 911 (or 9-911 from a campus phone) if the condition requires immediate medical attention.
- If poisoning is suspected, contact the Poison Control Center at 1 (800) 222-1222.

Staff and Faculty Work-Related Injuries

- It is important that all work-related injuries be reported immediately. During regular business hours, contact Workers' Compensation at (805) 730-4266 to report injuries and to obtain an authorization for initial medical treatment. If a work-related injury occurs outside of normal work hours (M-F 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.), contact the Workers' Compensation office at (805) 730-4266 within one business day. Obtain medical care at Urgent Care or Emergency Room.
- If an employee is hospitalized for 24 hours or more (other than for observation), or has an injury that results in a partial or full loss of limb (amputation), or loss of life, contact Risk Management at (805) 730-4266 immediately. The campus must report these injuries to OSHA within 8 hours of the event.

Student Injuries

- Students (not staff/faculty) can be seen at Student Health and Wellness Services at (805) 965-0581 x2298. If the victim needs immediate medical assistance call 911 (or 9-911 from a campus phone).

Todo personal

- Llame al departamento de seguridad de SBCC al (805) 730-4200 o 911 (o 9-911 de un teléfono de planta de campus), si la condición requiere atención medica inmediata.
- Si se sospecha un envenenamiento, contacte el Centro de Control de Veneno a 1 (800) 222-1222.

Lesiones relacionadas al trabajo de empleados y el profesorado

- Durante horas hábiles regulares, contacte a Worker's Compensation at (805) 730-4266 para reportar una lesión y obtener una autorización para tratamiento medico inicial para lesiones que no sean emergencias. Si una lesión relacionada al trabajo ocurre fuera de horas de trabajo normales, (M-F 8a.m. a 5p.m.), contacte a Workers' Compensation al (805) 730-4266 dentro de un día hábil. Obtenga la asistencia médica en la sala urgente del cuidado o de urgencias.
- Si un empleado es hospitalizado por 24 horas o mas (mas allá de observación) o si tiene una lesión que resulta en la perdida parcial o total de un miembro (amputación), o la perdida de vida, contacte inmediatamente a Risk Management a (805) 730-4266. El campus debe reportar estas lesiones dentro de 8 horas del acontecimiento a OSHA.
