Any extenuating circumstances listed may require supporting documentation and must be submitted with this request.

Payment plans for Past Due Balances will only allow you to register for the upcoming/current semester only. If you would like to register for the semester following, you must complete your payment plan and have no outstanding debts to SBCC.

Past Due Payment Plans are administered through Nelnet Business solutions. This is an interest-free plan with a non-refundable \$25 setup fee.

Past Due Payment Plans will result in Transcript and Graduation Holds on the student account. The hold will not be removed from the student account until the Past Due balance is paid in full.

The petition will be returned if any pertinent information is missing.
