Article I - Name of the Club

The name of this Club will be The Dungeons and Dragons Club.

Article II - Purpose of the Club

The club has been organized to provide students with access to the fantasy role-playing game Dungeons and Dragons to facilitate better communication skills and create a social bond, also, it's fun.

Article III - Authority

The Club derives its authority directly from the Student Senate and indirectly from the College Board of Trustees.

Article IV - Membership

Membership is open to all SBCC students regardless of their religious affiliations, gender, age, sexual orientation, ethnicity, etc.

Article V - Meetings

Regular meetings of the Club will be determined by the membership at its initial meeting each semester and reported to the Office of Student Life, room CC-217.

Article VI - Officers

Overseer (President)– Preside over all meetings. Call special meetings.

Elder Spectator (Vice Presidents) – Supports the Overseer, takes over in his/her absence.

Gazer (Secretary/Treasurer) – Keeps financial records and minutes from club officer meetings.

Henceforth club members shall be referred to as Adventurers.

Article VII - Elections

Officers shall serve two semester terms and will be elected each Fall.

Article VIII - Amendments

The Constitution shall be amended upon the approval of 75% of the Adventurers.
